




Southbank Bookshop Crawl



This is a version of a Group Bookshop Crawl we ran last year which was really fun and takes in a lot of London's more unusual bookshops, and even one which isn't a bookshop at all!


Begin at The Gilded Acorn (1 Portsmouth St, WC2A 2ES), the bookshop on the campus of LSE, aspiring to be the world's most sustainable bookshop. Once you've finished, wander over Waterloo Bridge and head towards the eclectic joys of the Southbank Book Market, hiding away under the arches of the bridge.

From here you can see the iconic National Theatre. Take a short walk and visit its' bookshop (National Theatre, SE1 9PX) - note there are also accessible toilets and a cafe here alongside the excellent collection of general fiction, drama and plays and related non-fiction.

After this, head back on yourself to explore the Southbank Centre, which has Foyles on the ground floor, and although it's not a bookshop, the National Poetry Library on the top floor is well worth a browse for anyone interested in poetry.

A short walk down the road (past the Old Vic Theatre) will bring you to another, much smaller theatre, which has a bookshop attached!

Discover some brilliant second hand books with a focus on drama and plays at The Calder Bookshop Theatre (51 The Cut, SE1 8LF), and a final longer walk along the back streets towards The Tate will bring you to Marcus Campbell Art Books (43 Holland St, SE1 9JR), where the art lovers can revel!



London Bookshop Crawl


