
Downloadable itinerary


There are so many bookshops in Bristol that you probably won't get through them all in a day, but feel free to pick and choose the parts of this itinerary which are useful to you. I've started at Bristol Temple Meads, but again adjust for your own starting point.



From the station, follow the map to **Beware of the Leopard Books** (St Nicholas St, BS1 1LJ), one of the oldest bookshops in southwest. When you're done, head down the road to **Stanfords** (29 Corn St, BS1 1HT) and then to **Bloom and Curll** (74 Colston St, BS1 5BB), a second hand bookshop, via **Ahh Toots** (Christmas St, Bristol) if you're in need of a (vegan friendly) cake stop.

When you're done, head down to **The Last Bookshop** (60 Park St, BS1 5JN), where all the books are £3 and under, and then onto **Dreadnought Books** (125 St George's Rd, BS1 5UW), an eclectic second hand bookshop. On that way you'll walk down College Street, where Samuel Taylor Coleridge once lived.





A slightly longer walk brings you round to **Bookhaus** (Unit 4, Rope Walk, BS1 6ZJ), and if you still have energy after that you can head up to **Storysmith (**236 North St, BS3 1JD).


Other shops on the bookshop crawl are located in slightly separate areas of Bristol, so we've included them on the next page as additional routes.

Clifton


Beginning at The Victoria Rooms, which once held readings and performances from Charles Dickens, Sarah Bernhardt & Oscar Wilde, walk down the road to Clifton Community Bookshop (10 Clifton Rd, Clifton, BS8 1AF).
Once you've finished exploring here continue down the road to Oxfam Books (26 Princess Victoria St, BS8 4BU)

Bishopston

Beginning at **St Andrews Park** (which has a playground and a children's paddling pool, if you're bookshop crawling with kids), walk down the road to **Books for Amnesty** (103 Gloucester Rd, BS7 8AT). When you've finished here keep going up the road to **Gloucester Road Books** (184 Gloucester Rd, Bishopston, BS7 8NU), where they'll be offering free goodies with any Little Toller book!

Along Gloucester Road there are several great cafes to stop for lunch or a snack, including **FED** (soup,salad,quiches, sausages rolls etc), and **Bomboloni** (brunch, pizza and pasta).

A longer walk will bring you to **Max Minerva's** (39 North View, Westbury Park, BS6 7PY), one of the cities fantastic indie bookshops, who'll be offering a 10% discount for bookshop crawlers
