





Hackney & Bow Bookshop Crawl




Start this epic undertaking at one of the newer bookshops on our list, Bard Books (341-343 Roman Rd, E3 5QR), an indie bookshop created for the local community. A 10 minute walk from here will bring you to recently relocated Claire de Rouen Books, previously an inhabitant of the Charing Cross Road and now continuing the legacy at 260 Globe Road, Bethnal Green. Over the road at 247 you'll find Jambala Charity Bookshop, which is the bookshop of London Buddhist Centre and sells all sorts alongside the selection of books!

A 10 minute walk brings you to The People's Letters (395 Cambridge Heath Rd, E2 9RA), a co-operative bookshop and community space, and another of the city's newer bookshops. Another 12 minutes or so will bring you to Broadway market, home to three incredible bookshops: The Broadway Bookshop (6 Broadway Mkt, E8 4QJ), Artwords (20-22 Broadway Mkt), and Donlon Books (75 Broadway Mkt, E8 4PH).





Take the 55, 106 or 254 bus from King Edward's Road (Stop LP) to Glenarm Road, and walk up the road to beautiful indie bookshop Pages of Hackney (70 Lower Clapton Rd, E5 0RN). Don't forget to explore the basement too!





One last bus journey will bring you to the final two bookshops! Take the 106 from Clapton Girls Tech College (Stop L) to Stoke Newington Church Street and walk up the road to lovely, spacious indie Stoke Newington Books (159 Stoke Newington High St, N16 0NY). When you finish here, a 3 minute walk up the road brings you to Abney Books, located just next to Abney Park Cemetery and filled with an eclectic range of great books. Show them your bookshop crawl ID for some fun extras too.
