



Begin this bookshop crawl at lovely indie West End Lane Books (277 W End Lane, NW6 1QS), after which a short walk brings you to House of Books (184 W End Lane, NW6 1SG). Once you've finished your browsing here, a 10 ish minute walk will bring you to Camden Art Centre (Arkwright Rd, NW3 6DG), where as well as books on art of all sorts, you can also explore the upstairs exhibitions.

A slightly longer 15 minute walk will bring you to Waterstones (68 -69 Hampstead High St, NW3 1QP), part of a little cluster of bookshops all a short walk from each other - Oxfam Books (45 Heath St, NW3 6UA) and Keith Fawkes (1-3 Flask Walk, NW3 1HJ), a second hand bookshop and antique store, are part of this section.

Head to the end of Flask Walk and turn right, and you'll reach newest addition to this itinerary, The Well Walk Theatre, Cafe & Bookshop (49 Willow Rd, NW3 1TS), where you can book tickets for their show of the month (daily at 11am and 3pm), browse the bookshop and grab a quick drink and snack!



A final 10 minute walk and you'll reach Daunt Books' Hampstead branch (51 S End Rd, NW3 2QB), where you can browse to your hearts' content!
