
Hastings




Downloadable itinerary

This is a lovely, walkable route through the beautiful historic town of Hastings. There are lots of other things to incorporate into your bookshop crawl along with the bookshops!



From the station, follow the map to **Bookbuster** (39 Queens Rd, TN34 1RE), in the old Blockbuster building, which sells Warhammer, t shirts DVDs and records alongside their books! When you finish browsing here, head up the road to **Printed Matter Bookshop** (185 Queens Rd, TN34 1RG), where there is an eclectic range of books and some discounts scattered through the store!



If you'd like a little non-book related detour, head through West Hill to the **Smugglers**Adventure where you can find out all about the history of smuggling in the area in a series of tunnels! Interactive and good for kids & adults.

From here (or from Printed Matter if you prefer to bypass the history), you have two options - either head to **Endlings** (3BS, 12 Courthouse St, TN34 3BA) for paintings, prints, books and things, or over to **Hare & Hawthorn** (51 George St, TN34 3EA) and then down the road to **Albion Books** (34-35 George St, TN34 3AQ).

Another short walk along the seafront will bring you to **The Hastings Bookshop** (5 Trinity St, TN34 1HG). From here you can either circle back to the station, or head up to **The Bookkeeper** (1a Kings Rd, St Leonards on Sea, TN37 6EA), about a 20 minute walk away.

Other Fun Things to do



in Hastings

If you find yourself with extra time in Hastings there are lots of fun things to do! Here are some of them:

Blue Reef Aquarium

Rock-a-Nore Rd, TN34 3DW

A really interesting aquarium with an undersea tunnel and lots of fun interactive stuff for kids. A good size for a fairly quick visit.

The Shipwreck Museum

Rock-a-Nore Rd, TN34 3DW

This is a brilliant little free museum especially if you're interested in maritime history. Lots of information about various different wrecks, and some great interactive elements. Opposite the aquarium.

Hastings Castle

Castle Hill Rd, TN34 3JL

The ruins of the first Norman castle in England, built by William the Conqueror. Also the 1066 Story, a 20 minute film on the history of the castle.

Cliff Railways

West Hill, George St, TN34

A funicular railway running with wooden carriages through a tunnel, from the top to bottom (and bottom to top) of the cliff! A fun way to travel a short distance. This is the UK's steepest funicular railway.

Judge's Bakery

51 High St, TN34 3EN

A brilliant bakery with bread, cakes and pastries. Seasonal options. Gluten free bread available.
