



Finsbury Park & Islington Bookshop Crawl




This route can mostly be walked, with a short bus journey to join the two halves if you have the energy - alternatively you can just do one half (New Beacon Books to Ink@84) or the other (Of Books & Love to Oxfam).


Starting at New Beacon Books (76 Stroud Green Rd, N4 3EN), a long-established bookshop focusing on the works of Black authors from around the world, a 15ish minute walk or a short bus journey will then bring you to BookBar (166 Blackstock Rd, N5 1HA), where you can stop and enjoy a drink while you browse.

Almost next door is charity bookshop House of Hodge (174 Blackstock Rd, N5 1HA), where you're very likely to find a bargain! Once you're finished, another short wander will bring you to Ink@84 (84 Highbury Park, N5 2XE), which is another fantastic little indie bookshop with a big personality!



Jump on the bus after this (4 or 19 from Riversdale Rd, Stop EC to St Mary's Church) and wander to London's newest romance bookshop, Of Books and Love (50 Cross St, N1 2BA). When you finish here, you can pop in to Waterstones (11 Islington Green, N1 2XH) on your way to Upper Street Books (42 Upper St, N1 0PN), before finishing your bookshop crawl at Islington's Oxfam Books (48 Upper St, N1 0PN)
