



Greenwich & Blackheath




Do this route either way round and it connects with the Lewisham & Crystal Palace itinerary, should you still have time and energy for more bookshops when you're done!




We recommend starting in Greenwich and beginning at Waterstones. The Greenwich branch is one of Waterstones' arts & crafts flagships so if you've got a new hobby in mind, this is the time! As well as which, there's a cafe and loos so a great place to start your crawl. Just around the corner is a lovely Oxfam Bookshop (2 College Approach, SE10 9HY) - show them your bookshop crawl ID and see if anything exciting happens... and grab yourself a bargain or 5 while you're here! For more bargains, another short walk down the road brings you to Greenwich Book Time (277 Greenwich High Rd, SE10 8NB), where many of the books are £5 or under.

Depending on the weather, you can either walk through Greenwich Park or catch a bus (386 from Greenwich High Rd/Royal Hill to Royal Parade) and walk up the road to The Bookshop on the Heath (74 Tranquil Vale, SE3 0BW), a long established bookshop selling second hand and antiquarian books as well as maps, prints and art. A second Waterstones on this route is just around the corner at 34 Tranquil Vale, and when you're done here, a 15 minute walk will bring you to the final stop.

Halcyon Books (266 Lee High Rd, SE13 5PL) is a great place to end your crawl, with rooms full of second hand books, and coffee to enjoy while you browse!
