




# Newham, Stratford & Walthamstow Bookshop Crawl




This is an adventurous bookshop crawl, made for those who like a little journeying into the unknown (or the known, if you're a local!). It takes in 7 bookshops with three bus journeys, and a couple of longer walks, and you can do it in either direction. For the purposes of this itinerary we'll be starting at one of London's most established indie bookshops, Newham Bookshop (743-745 Barking Rd, E13 9ER), where they have a children's bookshop and an adult bookshop interlinked. Once you've had an extensive browse, you'll embark on your first public transport stint of the bookshop crawl, getting the 104 bus from Upton Park/Boleyn (Stop G) to Stratford Broadway and walk 5 minutes to Discover Children's Story Centre (383-387 High St, E15 4QZ). If you've got little bookshop crawlers with you, consider booking a ticket to the centre and spending a few hours exploring. If not, you can visit their bookshop without a ticket and discover a brilliant range of children's books!



If you're ready for crowds, a 15 minute ish walk will bring you to Foyles (74-75 Mountfitchet Rd, E20 1EH), where there's lots to explore before you jump back on the bus. Pick up the 97 bus from Stratford International Station (Stop E) to Grange Park Road and take a short walk to lovely indie Phlox Books (159 Francis Rd, E10 6NT), where they live by the mantra of 'books.booze.coffee'. Walk 14 minutes to Quinto Books (679 High Rd, E10 6RA), packed with second hand and collectible books.



Jump on the bus (69 from Leyton Midland Road Station, Stop NA to Walthamstow Central Station, and walk to Waterstones (Selbourne Walk Shopping Centre, E17 7JR). If you're bookshop crawling on Saturday, a final walk will bring you to Public Knowledge Books (90 Hoe St, E17 4QS), one of the newer additions to our bookshop crawl lists!



This is a suggested route only provided for the purposes of helping you organise your crawl. Feel free to follow it in whatever order and way you think best. Please check the Big List for details of any extras on offer over the weekend.
