


Oxford Circus & Marylebone




This route is entirely walkable, but please be warned that there are a couple of 15 minute plus walks in it! However, the variety of bookshops is so good we think your feet will forgive us.

Begin at Oxford Circus where a short walk brings you to Ibraaz, a multidisciplinary centre for art and ideas from the Global Majority. The bookshop in residence here, Maktaba at Ibraaz (93 Mortimer St, W1W 7SS), is run by established indie Burley Fisher Books, and curated by the Palestine Festival of Literature and you're bound to find some fascinating new additions to your bookshelves. This route includes several newly established bookshops, and your second stop, Traveller's Tales (87 Wimpole St, W1G 9RL) is one of them. Combining a curated travel bookshop with 'bespoke expedition travel design', it's the perfect place to go when planning future expeditions!

Once you're done here, another wander up the road will bring you to Daunt Books' flagship store, much instagrammed and where the books are famously organised by country rather than genre.

The first of your two longer walks will bring you to another new addition to London's literary landscape, Veranda Books (7 Seymour Pl, W1H 5BA), which specialises in translated fiction across all genres. After this, another long-ish walk will bring you to Archive Bookstore (83 Bell St, NW1 6TB) which is packed with second hand books and records.



If you have energy left after this, you can continue your explorations by taking the Bakerloo line from Marylebone to Queens Park and walking around the corner to Queens Park Books (87 Salusbury Rd, NW6 6NH). In nearby Paddington Old Cemetery, beloved author of Paddington Bear Michael Bond is buried

London Bookshop Crawl


