


Catford to Dulwich Semi Circular Bookshop Crawl





This one is fairly heavy on the bus journeys, but thankfully the buses are frequent and the journeys themselves aren't too long!

It's a semi circular route and you can do it in either direction, but we would recommend starting at excellent, diverse children's bookshop Moon Lane Books (300 Stanstead Rd, SE23 1DE), where you could browse for hours! After this, get on your first bus of the day (75 from Vancouver Road Stop U to Newlands Park, or 202 from Beechfield Road Stop W to Sydenham Station/Kirkdale) and visit one of South East London's oldest independent's, Kirkdale Bookshop (272 Kirkdale Rd, SE26 4RS). After this, another short bus journey (450 from Sydenham Station/Westwood Hill Stop C to Westow Street) will bring you to Bookseller Crow on the Hill (50 Westow St, SE19 3AF), another long established indie that's a fixture of the local landscape

Another bus (432 from Westow St Stop H to Gipsy Road) or a longer walk will bring you to Melanin Dreams (126 Norwood High St, SE27 9NH), an indie set up to 'shine a spotlight on Black and Brown protagonists'. When you've had a good browse here, wander down the road to The Book and Record Bar (20 Norwood High St, SE27 9NR), which has a large collection of second hand books, specialising in science fiction and vintage crime, among other things!

If you have energy left, a final bus (322 from Robson Rd/Norwood Rd Stop Q to Martell Rd) will bring you to Dulwich Books (6 Croxted Rd, SE21 8SW)
